






STEP 1 - Attach Mounting Screws, Lock Washers and Hex Nuts to Mounting bracket.

A. Line up a set of holes on the Mounting bracket (DD) and Holes on the Backplate. Thread Mounting Screws (CC) into the holes on the Mounting bracket (DD). Pass Lock Washers and thread Hex Nuts onto the Mounting Screws (CC). Hand tighten until snug.




STEP 2 - Attach Mounting bracket to Outlet Box

A. Pass the supply wires through the Mounting bracket (DD).

Attach the Mounting bracket (DD) to the Outlet Box with the head of the Green Ground Screw facing you. Secure it with **Outlet Box** Screws.

STEP 3 - Wire Connections

· Use standard wire connectors to make all wire connections. Twist connectors until wires are tightly joined together. Wrap each connection with approved electrical tape and carefully stuff all the connected wires into the Outlet Box.
