

Surface Mounting (A)


STEP 1: Remove the lens from the housing near at one of the ends by using the provided suction cup. Press the suction cup to absorb one side of the lens. Pull the suction cup to detach the lends from the luminaire housing (Figure 1A).


STEP 2: Use a screwdriver to punch out one of the holes and pass the electrical cable out from the housing.

STEP 3: Use the luminaire as a template by placing it on the junction box and marking the ceiling for the position of the four holes where the screws will go. Put the luminaire aside and drill the four holds. Insert an anchoring bolt (not included) into each hole. Screw the four mounting screw into each anchoring bolt, then connect the AC wires (Figure 2).

STEP 4: Install the lens starting at one end of the housing. Insert the lens onto the edge of the housing. Carefully squeeze the lens to engage opposite side with the housing. Repeat this action down the length of the lens until fully installed into the housing (Figure 2A).
