- All wiring connections should be capped with UL approved wire connectors.

## **Installation & Operation**

### **▲** WARNING


Disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the appropriate fuse at the fuse box. Turning the power off using the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.

**Ceiling Fixture** (this kit is designed to be used with steel luminaires) Removing un-needed parts:


- 1. Read and understand all warnings and notes stated before proceeding with retrofit.
- 2. Check your retrofit kit against parts list.
- 3. Shut off the power at the circuit breaker.
- 4. Remove diffuser (A) and the lamps (B). Loosen the nuts (C) to remove the ceiling pan (D) and gain access to the junction box. Disconnect lead wires, retain all other parts including the crossbar. (Fig. 1)
- 5. If you choose to remove the lamp holder(s) (E), make sure that all open holes are covered.
- 6. Carefully unpack your new retrofit kit and lay out all the parts on a clear area. Take care not to lose any small parts necessary for the installation.

#### **Installation Steps:**


- 6. Position LED engine on the pan and attach it to the fixture with supplied self-tapping screws. (Fig. 2)
- 7. Drill a 5/16" hole about 1" away from the LED engine. Use push-in grommet (not supplied).
- 8. Route LED retrofit kit wires (1 white, 1 black, 1 green) through the grommet. Confirm wires will not be pinched. Exposed lead wires should be only 4" or less in length.



- 9. Connect the wire harness leads to mains wiring inside the junction box using (3) wire nuts/connectors (WAGO).
  - **a.** Green wire to ground wire (bare or green)
  - **b.** Black or blue wire to line conductor (black)
  - c. White wire to neutral conductor (white)



10. Re-attach pan to the ceiling and secure the lens to luminaire.








